

# Pneumococcal Vaccine Update for Physicians and Clinicians

Streptococcal disease poses a significant health risk for patients at risk for serious disease. The goal of immunizing patients with pneumococcal vaccines is to prevent the spread of Streptococcus pneumoniae and invasive disease. There are two types of pneumococcal vaccines available in the United States: pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine (PPSV23) and pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV13, PCV15, and PCV20). Pneumococcal vaccination recommendations can be complicated to maneuver. With the approval of two new pneumococcal vaccines in 2023, guidelines have been updated for both adults and children.
