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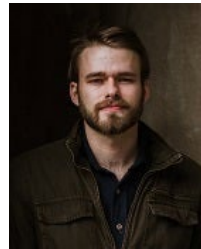
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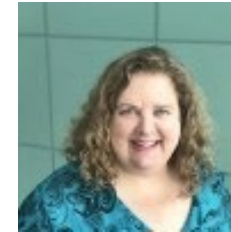

- Amplify international engagement in ASHRM's products and services.

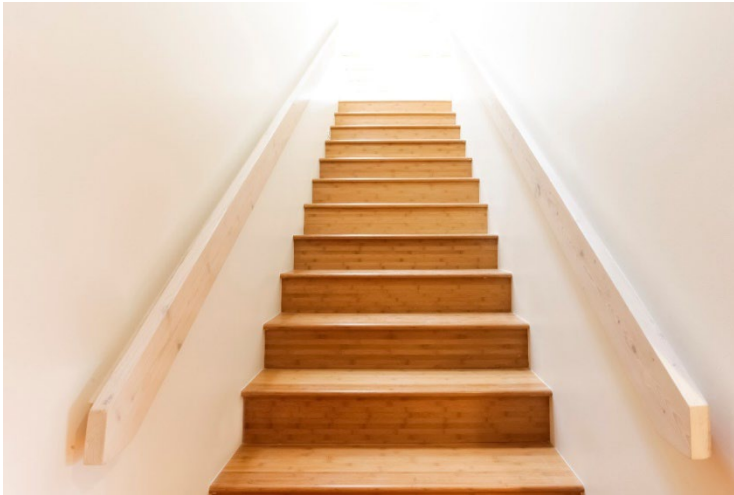
Goal 2: Create and Deliver Timely Insights
