## USDA Grants Lenders Temporary Exception to Offer Payment Deferrals for Agency Guaranteed Loan Programs

**WASHINGTON, March 31, 2020** – USDA Rural Development Deputy Under Secretary Bette Brand today announced that USDA is granting lenders a temporary exception to offer payment deferrals for Agency guaranteed loan programs due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Effective immediately until September 30, 2020, lenders may offer 180-day loan payment deferrals without prior agency approval for <u>Business and Industry Loan Guarantees</u>, <u>Rural Energy for America Program Loan Guarantees</u>, <u>Community Facilities Loan Guarantees</u>, and <u>Water and Waste Disposal Loan Guarantees</u>.
