

Do you know how the state survey process works? Do you know how to find the regulations you need to meet when your next survey occurs? The Kansas Hospital Association is offering a three-session webinar series covering survey readiness. This webinar series is designed to equip both new and experienced hospital leaders with the tools and resources to be ready for the next regulatory survey. The next webinar will be on April 23 and the final webinar will be on May 6.

Larry Van Der Wege, KHA's director of regulatory affairs and preparedness, will share regulatory information and draw on his previous hospital experiences to assist facilities in their efforts to be survey ready. During this webinar, he will:

- Review challenges that hospitals face with survey readiness;
- Provide location and better understanding of federal and state laws and regulations governing acute hospitals, critical access hospitals and rural emergency hospitals;
- Discuss what to expect in the initial survey process and what information to have ready to provide to surveyors; and
- Provide steps that hospitals can take to begin the journey of survey readiness.
